NOTICE OF RACE

The regatta organising authority is the Puerto Galera Yacht Club Inc. and is conducted under the auspices of the Philippine Sailing Association.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 All races will be completed using a pursuit race format. The object of “Pursuit Racing” is that the theoretical slowest boat starts first and the fastest boats start last. In theory all boats should finish simultaneously. The winner is the first yacht in each class to cross the finish line.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) 26 and 61.2 will be changed as follows: no signals will be given; and, a Protest Fee will be required in the event of a protest not being settled in advance of submission of protest forms. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. In addition, Rule 77 will not apply.
- 1.4 PY Handicap System as administered by the Organising Committee. The list of start times will be posted prior to the event.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising is permitted but boats wishing to carry their own sponsors advertising are invited to contact the race organizers to prevent conflict with race sponsors.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the following classes:
 - PY Cruiser/Racer
 - PY Cruiser
 - PY Multihull

NB: IRC boats will compete under PY Cruiser/Racer class and may receive corrected times relevant to their IRC Ratings on presentation of valid IRC Certification.

- 3.2 For a Class to be recognised by the Regatta, a minimum of 3 boats must enter the Class. Classes may be divided or combined subject to the number of entries in the Class.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee will be 6,000 Pesoper boat including VAT.
An Early Bird Discount of 1,000 Peso will apply ONLY IF the entry fee is PAID in CASH before October 1st 2019.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration will take place at the Puerto Galera Yacht Club from 1200 on Thursday, October 31ST 2019.

5.2 One race per day. The first start each day will not be before 1000 hours.

5.3 Racing will take place in Verde Island Passage. The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions, and described at the daily skippers briefing each race day morning.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available one week prior to the first race on the PGYC website at www.pgyc.org. And they will be included in the skippers pack.

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two Turn Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty.

8 BERTHING

The PGYC moorings are typically full so competitors should plan on anchoring at Boquete Sandbar or Dalaruan Bay anchorage. Limited moorings are available on a “first entry fee paid gets priority” basis. If you are intending to stay on a mooring before or after the regatta the normal daily charge will apply. Please contact the PGYC office for further details.

9 PRIZES

Daily prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each class.

Event Class trophies will be given to the first three places in each class.

Overall trophies will be awarded to the first three places in the event based on the low point system. If there are less than four entries in any class then only one competitor in that class shall be eligible for the award of an overall trophy.

4. For previously registered boats enter your sail number and your password and log in. Update details if necessary and press submit
5. If your boat is new to TopYacht and has not previously registered choose: Enter Boat NOT in TopYacht Boat Registry, complete the form and press submit.
